Penny Power



Each year the Penny Power fund-raiser supports a project sponsored by Mennonite Central Committee. **This year the Penny Power funds go to harvest clean water in Brazil.** In northern Brazil, the dry season lasts eight months of the year so rain gutters and cisterns are needed to store safe water for drinking and cooking.

- \$12 buys one bag of cement.
(It takes about 10 bags to build one cistern.)
- \$38 provides rain gutter material for one cistern.

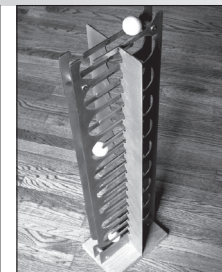
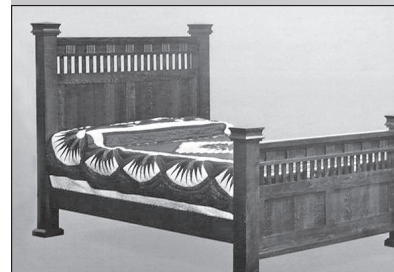
